



PURPOSE

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) requires Local Workforce Development Board to establish objective criteria and procedures to assess the effectiveness, physical and programmatic accessibility, and continuous improvement of one-stop centers and the one-stop delivery system.

The purpose of this policy is to communicate the Southwestern Oregon Local Workforce Development Area procedures for evaluating and certifying one-stop WorkSource Oregon centers in Southwestern Oregon.

POLICY

All Comprehensive and Affiliate One-Stop Centers in the area need to be certified by June 30, 2017 and for every three (3) years afterwards. The certification process includes an on-site, in person evaluation of each Comprehensive and Affiliate Center in the Southwestern Oregon area including an assessment of center effectiveness, physical and programmatic accessibility, and will include continuous improvement of centers and the one-stop delivery system (WIOA sec. 121(g)). Southwestern Oregon Workforce Investment Board staff will evaluate each Center and the one-stop delivery system to ensure compliance.

BACKGROUND

As required by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) and state policy. Southwestern Oregon Workforce Investment Board must certify the WorkSource Oregon (WSO) centers as comprehensive or affiliated sites every three years. There must be at least one comprehensive WorkSource center in the local workforce area. The basic criteria for certification of comprehensive and affiliated centers are as follows.

Comprehensive Center must have the following:

1. At least one WIOA title I staff person physically present, and the Center must provide career service as defined in 20 CFR 678.4309, 34 CFR 361.430, and 34 CFR 463.430.
2. Access to training services described in 20 CFR 680.200
3. Access to any employment and training activities carried out under section 134(d) of WIOA
4. Access to all programs and activities carried out by one-stop partners listed in 20 CFR 678.400 through 678.410, including the Wagner-Peyser Act ES program; and
5. Workforce and labor market information

Affiliate Center must meet the following:

1. One or more of the required one-stop partners' programs, services and activities are available to job seekers and employers (Exception: No stand-alone Wagner-Peyser program center)
2. Must comply with WSO Operational Standards (if Title I and II are present)
3. Must be branded WSO and include //a proud partner of the American Job Center network" (if Title I and II are present)
4. Must be physically and programmatically accessible to individuals with disabilities

Partner Sites/Specialized Centers:

1. Stand-alone on-required partner center or office
2. Must provide physical accessibility to individuals with disabilities

It is also required in the center certification process to conduct on-site evaluation of each center to assess center effectiveness, physical and programmatic accessibility, and continuous improvement of centers and the one-stop delivery system. Staff of SOWIB or an appropriate designee of SOWIB such as the One-Stop Operator, will complete evaluation of each center and the one-stop delivery system to ensure compliance with all criteria and requirements.

PROCESS

The process for assessing/certifying Southwestern Oregon one-stop centers is as follows:

- All WSO centers will be assessed on-site utilizing the WorkSource Assessment/Certification Checklist on an annual basis, by no later than June 30th of each year.
- In the event that a center either does not meet or falls out of compliance with certification criteria, technical assistance and/or a corrective action plan will be documented that includes the actions to be taken and the allotted period of time to meet the conditions for certification. These documents will be maintained with the certification documentation in accordance with record retention policies and procedures. SOWIB staff will re-evaluate within 90 days to determine center compliance with certification criteria.
- At the discretion of the SOWIB Executive Director, a center may be certified/re-certified while concurrently receiving technical assistance or completing corrective action. Certifications are documented using the WorkSource Assessment/Certification Checklist and will be reported to Higher Education Coordinating Commission in compliance with its One-Stop Center Certification Policy (WIOA 121g).


